

Governor attends Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra at Kalyan Gaon panchayat in Darrang District

Requests people to take the benefits of government welfare schemes

Guwahati, January 10: Participating in the nationwide campaign to ensure government schemes reach to the last man of the grass root, Assam Governor Shri Gulab Chand Kataria today attended 'Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra' (VBSY) programme at Kalyan Gaon panchayat in Darrang District.

It may be noted that VBSY is a campaign conceptualized by Prime Minister Narendra Modi to generate awareness among the beneficiaries through outreach activities to achieve saturation of government schemes across the country covering all Gram Panchayats, Nagar and Urban Local Bodies. The programme conducted in 35 districts with total events held 2358.

The Governor also spoke on various schemes like Ayushman, PMGAY, PMFBY, Jan Dhan Yojana, Jivan Jyoti Bima Yojana and many others. During the campaign, some of the beneficiaries also shared their experiences. They expressed happiness of the various schemes that they availed.

Later the Governor also visited ½ Baruaajar Gaon Panchayat and attended Viksit Bharat Yatra programme in Darrang district.
