## Governor visits Dima Hasao

## Interacts with the villagers of Samparidisa and interacts with them on key issues Pays rich tributes to freedom fighter, martyr Sambhudhan Phonglo

**Guwahati, February 12**: Assam Governor Shri Lakshman Prasad Acharya as a part of his maiden visit to Hima Hasao district, today went to Samparidisa village and spent time with the local villagers.

During his visit, the Governor interacted with the villagers and learnt from them about different government schemes that are on implementation in the village for the welfare of the villagers. He also took stock of the progress of the Samparidisa Piped Water Supply Scheme under the Haflong division, executed under JJM, and stressed the importance of maintenance legacy for the sustenance of the project.

The Governor who also visited Samparidisa LP School, interacted with the students and teachers. He asked the Headmaster of the school to ensure the highest quality standards in meal preparation for the Mid Day Meal of the children.
