

Governor inaugurates walking plaza in Raj Bhavan

Guwahati, February 16: Governor Shri Gulab Chand Kataria and First Lady of Assam Smt. Anita Kataria inaugurated a walking zone, childrens' park and parking area in Raj Bhavan campus today.
