

Assam Governor Shri Acharya pays tributes to former Prime Minister Late Atal Bihari Vajpayee

Guwahati, August 16: Assam Governor Shri Lakshman Prasad Acharya paid floral tributes to the portrait of former Prime Minister Bharat Ratna Late Atal Bihari Vajpayee on his death anniversary at Raj Bhavan today.

It may be noted that Late Atal Bihari Vajpayee who served as the prime minister of the country for three terms, died on 16, August, 2018.
