Guwahati, April 2: Assam Governor Shri Lakshman Acharya said that Madhabdev University established on the sacred land of Narayanpur and inspired by the cultural heritage of Assam is not just limited to the dissemination of knowledge but dedicated to fostering morality, a sense of service, and social responsibility among students.
