

Governor meets School Education department and takes stock of different schemes

Guwahati, September 21: Assam Governor Gulab Chand Kataria today took a brief of the activities of School Education department in the presence of education Minister Dr.Ranoj Pegu in the conference hall of Raj Bhavan today.

Mission Director, Samagra Shiksha, Assam Dr. Om Prakash and Secretary and Managing Director, ASTPPCL School Education Department Shah Nawaz Choudhury, gave a detailed presentation of the activities of the department.
