

Governor visits Dhubri; holds review of development schemes

Visits construction site of Dhubri-Phulbari bridge over the Brahmaputra

Guwahati, August 22: Assam Governor Gulab Chand Kataria today visited Dhubri and chaired a meeting with the District Commissioner and heads of the departments in the conference hall of the District Commissioner's office in Dhubri. He reviewed the Central and State governments' flagship programme to ensure that the benefits of various schemes are enjoyed by the grass root people.

Interacting with the officers, the Governor asked them to complete all the pending tasks. The Governor asked the DC to give employment to people under the MGNREGA scheme so that the people get their rightful vocations for earning their livelihood. He reviewed various aspects with regard to the construction of the bridge. He also appreciated the officials and expressed satisfaction with the progress. Accompanying him were Dibakar Nath, District Commissioner of Dhubri, Superintendent of Police Nabin Singh, and other officials from District Administration.
