Assam is a land of antiquity, of mystic traditions, of great beauty and mesmerising cultures, the land of Maa Kamakhya's glory yet renowned for traditions of the highest valour and martial spirit. From the era of Mahiranga Danava, the first king of Pragjyotishpura to the reign of Kumar Bhaskarvarman, monarch extraordinaire of ancient Kamarupa, to the valour and the glory of the mighty Ahoms in whose hands the modern identity of Assam was forged, Assam has been fortunate to have witnessed the reign of visionary monarchs and outstanding military commanders who have defended the land from invaders and crushed marauding armies with an iron fist.
