Assam is home to the famous one horned rhino at Kaziranga and other National parks which have variety of wild life including tigers and other flora and fauna. Assam is blessed with 5 National Parks and 18 Wildlife sanctuaries. While recognizing this wealth as our fundamental strength, our vision is to grow in economy with the growth of ecology. In this direction we have now decided to plant 100 million trees every year in Assam on a mission mode. Thus Assam wants to be front-runner and join the Global efforts against climate change.

Assam is nurtured by one of the greatest rivers of the world, Brahmaputra. Our civilization has grown along the mighty river. Majuli, the largest river island of the world in river Brahmaputra is known for its Satriya culture and ecological purity. The Barak is the other important river. Both rivers along with their many tributaries have a huge potential for river transport, tourism and industry. We hope to get access to the Bay of Bengal through Chittagong port in Bangladesh in near future.

Assam has very fertile land, abundant rainfall and produces significant quantity of fruits like banana, orange and pineapple and

spices like ginger and turmeric. Assam has a tremendous potential for agro processing industry.

Assam Tea is famous throughout the world. Assam has around 850 tea gardens and 1,30,000 small tea growers. You will be amazed to know that there are 20 golf courses and heritage clubs embedded in the scenic tea gardens. The Petroleum industry in India started at Digboi in Assam and we have today four refineries and significant petroleum as well as natural gas reserves.

Assam has over 20 million people in the working age group heralding a new era for youth led development. The State has a large pool of skilled workforce, adept in IT, English language and communication skills. Assam intends to make over 1 million people job ready with advanced skills.

We have taken inspiration from the Prime Minister's Act East Policy and set up a separate Act East Policy Affairs Department. We propose to make Guwahati as India's gateway to ASEAN. We have notified the State Capital Region.
